La Ferme de Berwausault

The owners of this sheep farm, Isabel and Bernard Pauquay, launched a bed and breakfast last year that is already attracting an international clientele. Situated 15 minutes from Verviers, Eupen and Liège, the B&B consists of four rooms plus a popular *table d'hôte* serving regional produce such as the famous and pungent Herve cheese. The renovated barn can accommodate up to 15 people and has a terrace overlooking a valley. Breakfast includes homemade jam and products from the farm. The couple have deliberately created a convivial business that is both nature- and family-orientated. A large garden has plenty of activities to keep little ones happy with boules, a sandpit, swings and badminton. Double rooms with breakfast from €55, extra beds for children available. Evening meal by reservation €17.50, €10 for children, picnic €6.

A Ravel cycle track lies nearby and other local activities include horse riding, mountain biking and walking. It's also possible to visit the Siroperie Artisanale d'Aubel, which produces syrups, jams and apple juice – guided tours are given every Saturday afternoon – a cider factory, the American World War



Two cemetery Henri-Chapelle at Hombourg-Vogelsang, the Abbey of Val-Dieu (guided tours of the 1216 Cistercian abbey and brewery year-round by appointment), Blegny Mine (an authentic coal mine just outside Liège), plus walks and cruises on the River Meuse.
